Burelage (or "Netzunterdruck" in German) is a fine overall network of dots or lines printed on the face of a stamp, usually done to discourage counterfeiting or the reuse of a stamp.

German Empire stamps diagonally overprinted "Danzig" with a bar in blue or carmine

#32-43, 45 and 46 are known as the "kleiner Innendienst" (small office work) issues in Germany

#44, 47 and 48 are known as the "großer Innendienst" (big office work) issues in Germany.

These stamps were not to be sold in public. The stamps were officially intended to be attached to mail by post office employees at the counter. However, most of the stamps were just sold.
