According to the March 2000 American Philatelist, the forgeries were actually printed by the printer of the originals! The originals are usually on good quality white paper, the forgeries on "brownish and cheaper". On the stamps with the woman holding the rifle, the originals have a thick line between the frame at the top and the frame containing the circle with the woman, while on the reprints there are two thin lines. On the Prince George stamps the top right frame line is double, while forgeries are single.
