1919 Russian Stamp surcharged also functioned as currency, as printed on the reverse unwatermarked, imperf



Stamp: Scott #52 Banknote: Pick #s369



Translates as: circulates as currency" As with other Russian issues of the era, some stamps also functioned as currency

Early in 1919, a 50 kopeck imperforate stamp was issued which contained a circle enclosing the Coat of Arms. Inscribed were the words "Crimean Border Government" in Russian along with the words "revenue" is printed down the left and "postage" down the right. The stamp was issued for both postage use as well as for currency.
