Acknowledgement-of-receipt stamps required the recipient to sign a receipt as proof of delivery. In most countries payment for this service was indicated by stamping the letters "A.R." (conveniently, the abbreviation is appropriate in English, French and Spanish). Colombia, Chile, Panama and El Salvador issued acknowledgement-of-receipt stamps.

Montenegro is the only country outside of Latin America to issue acknowledgement-of-receipt stamps.
